Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed Project is to realign an existing drainage to provide long-term stability to the South Vine Street Bridge.

The proposed project activities include:

- Realigning 310 feet of an unnamed drainage to 24 feet south of its current location, including 3,400 cubic yards of cut and fill material; and
- Restoring all temporary impacts associated with the project and implementing bioengineered bank stabilization practices.

No mitigation is proposed.

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
