TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR E & J GALLO, TURNER ROAD VINTNERS, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

Enclosed are the Notice of Public Hearing, Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs), and Tentative Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) for E & J Gallo's (Discharger) Turner Road Vintners in San Joaquin County. A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) at its 20/21 June 2024 meeting, as explained in the enclosed Notice of Public Hearing.

To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the Tentative WDRs should be submitted to this office via email to centralvalleysacramento@waterboards.ca.gov with a carbon copy (cc) to dina.calanchini@waterboards.ca.gov, no later than **5:00 p.m. on 29 April 2024**. Absent a showing of good cause and lack of prejudice to other parties, the Board Chair may exclude comments and evidence received after this deadline.
