On August 1, 2022, Sweetwater Company filed petitions for change for water right Licenses 370, 1385, and 1386 (Applications 1150, 4123, and 4124) with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division) pursuant to Water Code section 1701. Following is a summary of the Licenses and changes requested with the petitions.

Toe Drain of West Levee of Sacramento River Deep Water Ship Channel

- 1) North 1,891,388 feet and East 6,664,158 feet, located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21, T6N, R3E, MDB&M
- 2) North 1,889,588 feet and East 6,663,358 feet, located within SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21, T6N, R3E, MDB&M

###### ***Proposed:***

Addition of POD

North 1,882,276 feet and East 6,649,567 feet, located within SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T6N, R3E, MDB&M

##### Seasons of Diversion:

- License 370: April 1 to October 31 of each year
- License 1385: November 1 of each year through March 31 of the succeeding year
- License 1386: January 1 to December 31 of each year

##### Amounts of Water:

- License 370 authorizes a direct diversion of 23 cubic feet per second (cfs)
- License 1385 authorizes a direct diversion of 11.64 cfs
- License 1386 authorizes a direct diversion of 7.12 cfs
