SUBJECT: **Browning-Ferris Industries, Inc., Ox Mountain Sanitary Landfill  
Class III Waste Management Facility, Half Moon Bay, San Mateo  
County – Updated Waste Discharge Requirements**

CHRONOLOGY: 1999 – Adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Ox  
Mountain Sanitary Landfill

DISCUSSION: The Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) updates WDRs for the Ox  
Mountain Landfill, near Half Moon Bay.

Ox Mountain Landfill, located in Corinda Los Trancos Canyon, consists of 191 acres and has a capacity of 48.3 million cubic yards. The landfill began accepting waste in 1976 and is scheduled to close in 2027. Non-hazardous residential, commercial, and industrial waste is disposed at the landfill.

The Tentative Order requires submittal of construction plans, construction completion and quality assurance reports for various stages of landfill construction, water quality monitoring reports, and stormwater control implementation reports. Additional tasks include an updated landfill stability evaluation and mitigation of vector impacts on downstream surface water quality.

We circulated the Tentative Order to the Discharger and interested parties. We have revised the Tentative Order as appropriate, based on the minor comments provided by the Discharger (attached), and consider all issues resolved.
