SUBJECT: LEAKING UNDERGROUND FUEL TANK CLEANUP PROGRAM – Status Report

DISCUSSION: Attached are three tables indicating progress made during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of fiscal year 07-08 toward our underground storage tank (UST) program goals. As shown on the attached tables we are on track to meet or exceed goals for closures (12/30), for reviewing monitoring reports (77/350), and for formal and informal enforcements (104/400). The majority of the informal enforcement is meetings and phone calls with the responsible parties regarding their sites. The formal enforcement comprises Water Code Section 13267 enforceable orders for technical reports requiring investigations to determine the source and extent of contamination and proposal of a cleanup plan.

Water Board UST program staff hosted the UST Program Roundtable in early August. We will also schedule another Bay Area UST Program Roundtable for the seven local oversight programs and four local implementing agencies sometime in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of the fiscal year.
