### **SUBJECT OF THE CANCELLED HEARING**

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) scheduled a hearing to receive evidence relevant to determining whether to adopt, with or without revision, a draft Cease and Desist Order (CDO) against Stanford Vina Ranch Irrigation Company (Stanford Vina).

Subsequently, Stanford Vina and the Division of Water Rights' Prosecution Team reached agreement and requested postponement of the hearing. By Notice of Postponement of Public Hearing, dated December 3, 2014, the State Water Board postponed the December 8<sup>th</sup> hearing. On December 15, 2014, the State Water Board's Executive Director issued Water Right Order [WR 2014-0090-EXEC](#) (Order Approving Stipulation and Cease and Desist Order) and, by consequence, Stanford Vina withdrew its hearing request. Accordingly, no hearing is required to be held on this matter, and the previously postponed hearing is cancelled.
