On December 1, 2017, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) received a joint request from both parties to the above-referenced hearing, the Division of Water Rights Prosecution Team (Prosecution Team) and Delbert and Jeff Lehr, to indefinitely postpone the hearing dates and exhibit submission deadline while a decision regarding the parties' settlement agreement remains pending before State Water Board's Executive Director.
