BACKGROUND

The 2021/22 State Budget includes \$650 million each for drinking water and wastewater infrastructure projects. The funding, which will be awarded as grants, must be committed to projects by June 30, 2024, and disbursed by June 30, 2026. Consistent with the law, priority for drinking water funds will be given to disadvantaged communities, and priority for wastewater funds will be given to septic-to-sewer projects with local investment. Up to 10 percent of the funds may be used for technical assistance and capacity building in disadvantaged communities. The implementation plan is expected to go before the State Water Board for consideration in early 2022.
