

#### Chapter 22. State Policy for Water Quality Control

§ 2919. ~~A-Site Specific Exceptions to the Sources of Drinking Water Policy for Old Alamo Creek.~~

(a) State Water Board Resolution No. 2006-0008 provided a site specific exception to State Water Board Resolution 88-63, Sources of Drinking Water Policy, for Old Alamo Creek in Solano County.

(b) State Water Board Resolution 2015-0002 provided a site-specific exception to State Water Board's Resolution 88-63, Sources of Drinking Water Policy, for groundwater beneath portions of the Royal Mountain King Mine Site in Calaveras County.
