



# TRIBAL LISTENING SESSION ON BAY-DELTA PLAN UPDATE

The State Water Board is responsible for protecting beneficial uses of water in the Bay-Delta and its tributaries in part through its Bay-Delta Plan, which is currently being updated and implemented. The Bay-Delta Plan establishes: 1) beneficial uses of water, 2) water quality and flow objectives needed to protect those uses, and 3) a program of implementation. This listening session will focus on tribal engagement with the update and implementation of the Bay-Delta Plan and strategies for incorporating Traditional and Tribal Cultural and Ecological Knowledge into these processes.
