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STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD CONSIDERATION OF THE ADOPTION OF THE FINAL ORDER AMENDING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE U.S. BUREAU OF RECLAMATION'S (RECLAMATION) WATER RIGHT PERMITS FOR THE CACHUMA PROJECT (PERMITS 11308 AND 11310 (APPLICATIONS 11331 AND 11332))

This letter responds to the April 24, 2019 correspondence from the Cachuma Conservation Release Board, the Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District, the City of Lompoc, and the Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District, Improvement District No. 1 (collectively, the "Local Interests") in which the Local Interests request that the meeting date for the State Board's consideration of the Cachuma Project final order be extended at least 30 days.

The March 27, 2019 cover letter for the Revised Draft Order Amending the Terms and Conditions of the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation's (Reclamation) Water Right Permits for the Cachuma Project (Permits 11308 and 11310 (Applications 11331 and 11332)) states that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will consider adoption of the revised draft order tentatively scheduled for the June 4, 2019 Board meeting

On April 12, 2019, the Cachuma Project Hearing parties were notified of a 30-day extension to submit comments for revised draft order. Due to the extension of time to submit comments, the revised draft order is no longer tentatively scheduled to be considered for adoption at the June 4, 2019 Board meeting. Parties will be notified when a new tentatively scheduled Board Meeting has been selected for consideration of adoption. The State Water Board will issue a public notice of that meeting at least ten days in advance.
