

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 78- 60

AUTHORIZATION FOR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO  
NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A STANDARD AGREEMENT WITH THE  
DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES TO INVESTIGATE AND REPORT  
ON FOUR SMALL GROUNDWATER SUBBASINS WITHIN THE SANTA ANA  
REGION

WHEREAS:

1. During the preparation of the Basin Plan for the Santa Ana Region, several small subbasins, which were tributary to larger basins and which consisted of minor water-bearing areas with little development or water quality impacts, were omitted in the planning program due to time and fiscal limitations.
2. Since the adoption of the Basin Plan in 1975, the Regional Board has been criticized for the limitations placed on waste dischargers, without reliance of information on water quality and basin objectives, in said areas.
3. A proposed contract, in the amount of \$37,500, with the Department of Water Resources (DWR), would provide for an investigation to determine and recommend water quality objectives of four small groundwater subbasins: (1) Irvine Forebay (southeast portion) in Orange County; (2) La Habra area in Orange County (adjacent to Region 4); (3) Upper Temescal in Riverside County (includes Coldwater, Bedford, and Lee Lake subbasins); and (4) Santiago, Silverado, and Modjuska Canyon areas in Orange County.
4. Said contract will be completed in ten months, which will correspond to similar work on the Basin Plan update for concurrent Regional Board action on Basin Plan amendments.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a standard agreement with the Department of Water Resources to investigate and report on said four small groundwater subbasins within the Santa Ana Region, in the amount of \$37,500 of State Bond funds.
