RESOLUTION NO. 83-5

APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SANTA ANA RIVER BASIN (8) REVISING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE YUCAIPA-CALIMESA PROHIBITION ON SUBSURFACE LEACHING OR PERCOLATING WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS

WHEREAS:

1. On March 9, 1973, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region, (Regional Board) adopted a waste discharge prohibition on subsurface leaching or percolating systems in the Yucaipa-Calimesa area.
2. On June 7, 1973, exemption criteria were adopted which would allow the installation and operation of leaching or percolating waste disposal systems if specific criteria were met.
3. On April 11, 1975, the Regional Board adopted a Water Quality Control Plan for the Santa Ana River Basin (basin plan). This basin plan was approved by the State Board on April 17, 1975 by Resolution No. 75-28.
4. The basin plan incorporated the waste discharge prohibition adopted on March 9, 1973 for the Yucaipa-Calimesa area and called for the elimination of waste discharge from leaching or percolating systems by July 1, 1977.
5. On March 18, 1977, the Regional Board, by Resolution No. 77-87, revised the effective date of the Yucaipa-Calimesa area prohibition to July 1, 1980. This amendment was approved by the State Board on May 19, 1977 by Resolution No. 77-47.
6. On October 10, 1980, the Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 80-172 revising the effective date of the prohibition to January 1, 1982.
7. On January 22, 1981, the State Board adopted Resolution No. 81-7 approving the Regional Board's resolution to extend the effective date of the Yucaipa-Calimesa area prohibition to January 1, 1982.
8. On September 25, 1981, the Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 81-205 revising the effective date of the prohibition to January 1, 1983.
9. On December 17, 1981, the State Board adopted Resolution No. 81-102 approving the Regional Board's resolution to extend the effective date of the Yucaipa-Calimesa prohibition to January 1, 1983.
10. The Regional Board conducted a public hearing on November 12, 1982 regarding the effective date of the prohibition and considered all testimony and evidence presented at the hearing.
11. On November 12, 1982, the Regional Board adopted Resolution No. 82-298 revising the effective date of the prohibition to January 1, 1984.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the amendment to the basin plan revising the effective date to January 1, 1984 of the prohibition on subsurface leaching or percolating waste disposal systems in the Yucaipa-Calimesa area. Consideration of any future extension of the prohibition will be based on progress between now and January 1984 on the construction of the wastewater treatment facility and collection system by the Yucaipa Valley County Water District.
