AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY  
AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR CON-  
TINUED OPERATION OF THE TOXIC SUBSTANCES MONITORING  
PROGRAM IN FY 1983-84

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board clearly has the responsibility to control the occurrence of toxic substances in the waters of the State.
2. The State Board's Toxic Substances Monitoring Program is providing valuable information on the occurrence of toxic substances in the State's surface fresh waters.
3. It is desirable that this Program be continued, consistent with the State Board's emphasis on the control of toxic substances.
4. The Department of Fish and Game has qualified personnel, facilities, and experience to continue operation of this Program.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Fish and Game for continued operation of the Toxic Substances Monitoring Program through June 30, 1984, in an amount not to exceed \$180,000 in FY 1983-84 General Fund monies, subject to approval of the FY 1983-84 budget.
