AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT A SECTION 109(b) GRANT FROM THE U. S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING ACTIVITIES OF THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL INSTITUTE

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board wishes to continue the operator training activities of the Water Quality Control Institute.
2. Section 109(b) of the Clean Water Act provides funding for certain operator training activities and offers the opportunity to expand State training capability by becoming a "Section 109(b) funded State Training Center."
3. The Water Quality Control Institute must immediately vacate its current training facilities and needs updated training equipment.
4. A grant application has been submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency for \$88,680 to fund leased training center space and equipment.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to accept a Section 109(b) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency when it is awarded.
