APPROVING COMPLETION OF AMBAG's PHASE IV 208
AGRICULTURAL EROSION CONTROL PROJECT

WHEREAS:

1. The Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) is responsible for Water Quality Management Planning in the Monterey Bay Area.
2. AMBAG was awarded a Phase IV 208 grant to conduct four Water Quality Management Planning projects in the Pajaro Valley area.
3. One of these projects provided for identifying agricultural erosion problems, developing Best Management Practices (BMPs) to control problems, and identifying financial and institutional measures to implement the BMPs.
4. A report titled "Agricultural Erosion Control Project Report" was prepared describing the work which was conducted, results, and recommendation of this project.
5. Staff has reviewed this report, the BMPs, and other products and determined that the workplan requirements have been completed.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Approves the Agricultural Erosion Control Project Final Report as completing AMBAG's Phase IV 208 Agricultural Erosion Control Project.
2. Certifies the agricultural erosion control BMPs developed as part of this project.
3. Direct the Executive Director to transmit the Final Report to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency requesting their approval.
