RESOLUTION NO. 86-68

ADOPTION OF FY 1987 CLEAN WATER GRANT PROJECT PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS:


1. The Division of Clean Water Grants has proposed a FY 1987 Project Priority List based on Regional Board and public input consistent with the proposed Amendments to the Clean Water Act.
2. The Clean Water Act allows the states to set aside up to 20 percent of their allotment to fund major sewer system rehabilitation (Needs Category IIIB), new collection sewers and appurtenances (Needs Category IVA), and combined sewer overflow correction (Needs Category V) projects. The current level of federal funding is not sufficient to meet the needs of all EPA needs categories.
3. The Clean Water Act requires delegated states to reserve a portion of their annual allotment for: 1) Construction Management Assistance Grants (CMAG); 2) Water Quality Management [205(j)]; 3) Innovative/Alternative Grants; and 4) Advance of Allowance. A balance of \$1.3 million exists in the Advance of Allowance reserve.
4. In addition to new awards, there is a need to provide funding for reasonable and necessary grant increases in FY 1987.
5. The Clean Water Act requires that construction grants under Section 201(g)(1) shall be made only to designated management agencies, and only for construction of treatment works which conform to an approved water quality management plan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The FY 1987 Priority List dated September 4, 1986 is adopted.
2. Twenty percent of the state's FY 1987 allotment is set aside for construction of new collector sewers and appurtenances only.
3. Four percent of the FY 1987 allotment is reserved for CMAG; one percent for Water Quality Management; four percent for Innovative/Alternative projects; and no additional funds set aside in FY 1987 for the Advance of Allowance reserve.
4. A sum of \$50 million in federal funds for grant increases is approved to compete with new awards on a "first-come, first-served" basis in FY 1987.
5. In accordance with Section 208(d) of the Clean Water Act, all agencies listed on the FY 1987 Priority List are hereby designated as management agencies for the construction of treatment works under Section 201(g)(1) of the Act, and the identified treatment works conform to an approved water quality management plan.
