FUNDING FOR A POLLUTION STUDY FOR THE LAKE CANYON COMMUNITY

WHEREAS:


1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 established the Supplemental State Grant Assistance Program to help small communities with funding for treatment works.
2. The Supplemental State Grant Assistance Program provides for state grant assistance up to 97.5 percent of the cost of pollution studies.
3. The need for a pollution study in Lake Canyon has been documented by high coliform levels in local streams.
4. A Community Improvement Committee has been formed within Lake Canyon and is eager to assist in a pollution study.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize a grant to be issued to County Sanitation District No. 4 of Santa Clara County for an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for a pollution study for the Lake Canyon area.
