RESOLUTION NO. 88-119

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF
HEALTH SERVICES AND THE STATE BOARD ON WATER RECLAMATION

WHEREAS:

1. The Department of Health Services, the State Board and the nine California Regional Water Quality Control Boards have authority to regulate the use of reclaimed water.
2. The Department is the primary State agency responsible for protection of public health.
3. The State Board and the Regional Boards are the primary State agencies charged with protection, coordination, and control of water quality.
4. To promote and facilitate the use of reclaimed water in the State, it is essential that the regulatory activities are well coordinated and effective, and that areas of concern to the State agencies are addressed.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board has determined to enter into an agreement with the Department of Health Services on water reclamation and to authorize the Chairman of the State Board to sign the Memorandum of Agreement on behalf of the State Board.
