## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 70-19

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE
AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES
CONTROL BOARD AND THE CITY OF SAN JOSE
(ACTING ON BEHALF OF "SOUTH BAY WASTE WATER DISCHARGERS")
TO CONDUCT A SUBREGIONAL PLANNING STUDY OF
TREATMENT, RECLAMATION, AND DISPOSAL OF
MUNICIPAL AND INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATERS
IN THE SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA

WHEREAS, The State Water Resources Control Board has determined that there is need for cooperative studies to expand upon previous work conducted as part of the San Francisco Bay-Delta Program; and

WHEREAS, The Board has determined that it is necessary to develop data on alternative methods for treatment, disposal, and reclamation of municipal and industrial wastewaters of the South Bay in sufficient detail to provide a basis for long-range planning decisions by both waste dischargers and regulatory agencies; and

WHEREAS, The study will be funded jointly by the South Bay Waste Water Dischargers and the Board, with the amount expended by the South Bay Waste Water Dischargers at least equal to the amount expended by the Board; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board enter into a contract with the City of San Jose on behalf of South Bay Waste Water Dischargers for the conduct of a subregional planning study of treatment, reclamation, and disposal of municipal and industrial wastewaters in the South Bay area; the study to be funded jointly by the Board and the South Bay Waste Water Dischargers, with the Board's share not to exceed \$30,000 and the South Bay Waste Water Dischargers to equal or exceed the amount paid by the Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Executive Officer of the Board is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Board.
