RESOLUTION NO. 75-7

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR A STUDY OF "REDUCTION OF UNIT TOXICITY EMISSION RATES FROM WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANTS BY OPTIMIZATION OF THE CHLORINATION PROCESS

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board sponsored preparation of the "Interim Manual for Wastewater Chlorination and Dechlorination Practices".
2. The State Board submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency a proposal for a study of optimum design and operation of chlorination facilities, with the Department of Health to conduct the study under contract with the State Board.
3. To comply with federal law requiring 25 percent nonfederal funding for each project funded by EPA, State Board funding of \$10,000 is required to add to Department of Health funds.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That this Board authorize the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to execute an interagency agreement with the State Department of Health for an amount not to exceed the amount of the Environmental Protection Agency grant plus \$10,000, of Clean Water Bond Funds.
