


STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD

COMMENDING MR. RONALD B. ROBIE  
FOR HIS SERVICES TO THE

- WHEREAS, Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr., on March 1, announced the appointment of Ronald B. Robie as Director of the Department of Water Resources; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Robie had been the attorney member on the State Water Resources Control Board since April of 1969, and had been the Vice Chairman since October of 1972; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Robie's background in the field of water resources and water pollution control includes his service as an assistant to the late Assemblyman Carley V. Porter, then Chairman of the Assembly Water Committee, during the preparation and adoption of the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act; and
- WHEREAS, his devotion to the water and environmental fields has been further evidenced by his activity as professor at the University of the Pacific McGeorge School of Law; and
- WHEREAS, the State Water Resources Control Board believes that Ronald B. Robie will draw on his outstanding background and his dedication to excellence to assure the proper protection and use of the state's water resources in his new position as Director of Water Resources,
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Water Resources Control Board expresses its appreciation to Mr. Robie for his outstanding contributions toward the improvement of water quality and water rights programs during the past six years and for the pleasant and rewarding association with him.
