RESOLUTION NO. 78-38

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF INTERAGENCY
AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO
CONTINUE A PROGRAM OF BIOLOGICAL MONITORING FOR
TOXIC SUBSTANCES

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board has the responsibility to coordinate water quality-related investigations of state agencies and to conduct necessary surveillance and monitoring activities.
2. The State Board, with the concurrence of the Regional Boards, has completed development and design of a statewide monitoring network and has implemented portions of that network pursuant to State Board Resolution Nos. 76-57 and 77-22.
3. As part of the monitoring network, waters of the State are to be monitored for toxic substances by collection and analysis of resident aquatic organisms.
4. The Department of Fish and Game has the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desires to provide such services to the State Board, for an amount not to exceed \$106,400 for the period June 1, 1978 through April 30, 1980.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Fish and Game to continue a program for biological monitoring of toxic substances for an amount not to exceed \$106,400 for the period June 1, 1978 through April 30, 1980, subject to the availability of funds.
