RESOLUTION NO. 83-10

ADOPTION OF THE LAKE TAHOE BASIN WATER QUALITY PLAN AMENDMENT

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board adopted the Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan on October 29, 1980.
2. The Environmental Protection Agency approved the Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan on September 18, 1981, as meeting the requirements of Section 303(e) of the Clean Water Act.
3. The State Board released for public review and comment a Proposed Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan Amendment on November 5, 1982.
4. The Proposed Plan Amendment clarifies that waste discharge prohibitions in the Plan and waste discharge requirements implementing the discharge prohibitions do not specify the manner of compliance.
5. The Proposed Plan Amendment does not propose a program of "case-by-case-review," and is not expected to result in any change in the extent or location of development.
6. Based on the Proposed Plan Amendment and the comments received, the State Board has prepared a final Plan Amendment and a Summary of Public Comments including responses to the comments.
7. The State Board has reviewed the environmental documentation accompanying the Plan Amendment, including the amendment to Table IV-5 on Page 165 of the Plan, and finds that it is in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act and all applicable regulations.
8. The State Board finds that the Plan Amendment meets all applicable requirements of the California Water Code, and all applicable requirements of Section 303(e) of the Clean Water Act.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board adopts the Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan Amendment.
2. That the Executive Director shall file a Notice of Decision with the Secretary for Resources.
3. That the Executive Director shall submit the Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan Amendment to the Environmental Protection Agency for approval pursuant to Section 303(e) of the Clean Water Act.
