

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 83-13
APPROVING THE 205(j) PROJECT PRIORITY LIST
APPROVING THE 205(j) PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION WORKPLAN

WHEREAS:

1. The 1981 amendments to the Clean Water Act added section 205(j) authorizing states to use a maximum of 1 percent of their section 201 Clean Water Grant Funds for water quality management planning.
2. A total of \$3,627,640 in federal 205(j) grant funds are available. \$1,878,000 in federal fiscal year 1981-82 and \$1,749,640 in federal fiscal year 1982-83.
3. After extensive public review and comment the State Water Resources Control Board developed and approved on November 4, 1982 the 205(j) Program Implementation Plan and Priority Water Bodies Document.
4. The State Water Resources Control Board formed a Policy Advisory Committee to review 205(j) project proposals.
5. After reviewing the 205(j) project proposals the Policy Advisory Committee recommended that the State Water Resources Control Board fund selected projects.
6. The State Water Resources Control Board held a hearing on February 10, 1983, to receive comments on the Policy Advisory Committee funding recommendations.
7. The State Water Resources Control Board is the agency designated to administer the 205(j) water quality management planning program.
8. The State Water Resources Control Board has prepared a 205(j) Program Administration Workplan to be funded with \$625,000 of 205(j) grant funds.
9. Federal grant funds under section 106 of the Clean Water Act may be reduced by approximately \$1.7 million to approximately \$1.4 million.
10. The federal administration has indicated that States may use their 205(j) grant funds to make up the shortfall in section 106 grant funds.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Water Resources Control Board adopts the attached 205(j) Project Priority List.
2. That the State Water Resources Control Board approves the 205(j) Program Administration Workplan.

3. That the Executive Director shall transmit the 205(j) Project Priority List and the 205(j) Program Administration Workplan to the EPA Region IX, Regional Administrator for approval.
4. That the Executive Director shall request a partial grant from the EPA, Region IX Regional Administrator in the amount of \$625,000 to fund the 205(j) program administration activities of the State Water Resources Control Board.
