RESOLUTION NO. 83-24

ADOPTION OF UPDATE TO FY 1983 PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS:

1. There is about \$102 million worth of projects remaining on the fundable portion of the adopted FY 1983 Priority List.
2. The Board made a previous commitment to fund two key San Francisco project increases totaling about \$23.5 million.
3. The Congress, in appropriating construction grant funds for FY 1983, mandated the funding of the 1.0 MGD Aquaculture Pilot Study for the City of San Diego which is estimated to cost about \$15.6 million.
4. The Division made a previous commitment to fund the \$3.4 million Central Contra Costa Stage 5B Expansion project.
5. The needs proposed total about \$520 million in federal funds with about \$126 million available for obligation for the remainder of FY 1983.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The update to the FY 1983 Priority List including the funding priorities for the remainder of FY 1983, as proposed by the Division of Water Quality is adopted.
2. No further changes be made to the fundable portion of the FY 1983 List unless additional funds should become available.
