RESOLUTION NO. 83-50
CERTIFICATION OF "CURRENT REFLECTIONS OF WATER QUALITY
PLANNING IN THE MONTEREY BAY AREA" AS AN AMENDMENT TO
THE ASSOCIATION OF MONTEREY BAY AREA GOVERNMENT'S
208 WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS:

1. The Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) is responsible for Water Quality Management Planning in the Monterey Bay 208 Designated Area, and
2. AMBAG prepared a 208 Water Quality Management Plan which has been certified by the State Board and approved by EPA, and
3. AMBAG was awarded a Phase II 208 grant to conduct additional Nonpoint Source Control Planning studies which included preparing an update to AMBAG's 208 WQMP, and
4. AMBAG conducted these studies and prepared a supplement titled "Current Reflections of Water Quality Planning in the Monterey Bay Area" which contains the results, BMPs and recommendations of these studies, and
5. The AMBAG Board of Directors approved the supplement as an amendment to their WQMP, and
6. Region 3 staff have reviewed the supplement and find that it is consistent with the Basin Plan for the Monterey Bay Area, and
7. Staff has reviewed the supplement and the Phase II 208 AMBAG BMPs and determined that they meet the criteria for certification.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Approves all of AMBAG's Phase II 208 projects with the exception of the Agricultural Demonstration project as complete.
2. Certifies the AMBAG supplement "Current Reflections of Water Quality Planning in the Monterey Bay Area" as an amendment to the AMBAG Designated Area 208 WQMP, and
3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit the supplement to EPA for their approval.
