

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 83- 78

COMPLETING THE ASSOCIATION OF MONTEREY BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS'
PHASE III 208 SAN LORENZO RIVER WATERSHED PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

1. The Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) has been designated as the Areawide Waste Treatment Management Planning Agency in the Monterey Bay Area under Section 208 of the Clean Water Act, and
2. AMBAG has completed a Phase III 208 a planning program in the San Lorenzo Watershed consisting of three projects:
 - o Chronic Sediment Source Control
 - o Erosion Control Education and Enforcement,
and
 - o On-site Wastewater Management
4. These projects provided for developing Best Management Practices (BMPs) and identifying financial and institutional measures to implement the BMP, and
5. Final reports for each of the three projects were prepared describing the BMPs and recommended implementation actions, and
6. State Board staff has reviewed these reports and other products and finds that the workplan requirements have been completed and the BMPs meet the criteria for certification as part of AMBAG's Areawide Waste Treatment Management Plan.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board approves as complete AMBAG's Phase III 208 San Lorenzo River Watershed Program including the Final Reports for the three projects:
 - o Chronic Sediment Source Control
 - o Erosion Control Education and Enforcement
and
 - o On-site Wastewater Management
2. Certifies the BMP's developed, and

3. Directs staff to transmit the Final Reports for these projects to EPA requesting their approval.
