FRED DIERKER

WHEREAS, the waters under the jurisdiction of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board play an important role in the environmental, economic and social health of the Bay area; and

WHEREAS, Fred Dierker has served for 33 years as a senior official of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board, including the last 15 years as Executive Officer; and

WHEREAS, water quality has improved during the period Fred Dierker has served as Executive Officer and Senior Water Pollution Control Engineer of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board; and

WHEREAS, Fred Dierker played a vital role in implementing the California Clean Water Grant Program in the Bay area, resulting in the construction of over \$2 billion worth of pollution control facilities and the significant reduction in the pollutants contaminating Bay and ocean waters; and

WHEREAS, Fred Dierker has effectively coordinated efforts to protect San Francisco Bay, including the comprehensive investigations of estuarial waters, the San Francisco Bay-Delta Water Quality Control program and the Aquatic Habitat program; and

WHEREAS, Fred Dierker led the effort to restore San Francisco Bay shellfish beds; and

WHEREAS, Fred Dierker pioneered an effective program to detect pollution problems from underground tanks and has implemented an effective program to solve the problems detected; and

WHEREAS, Fred Dierker administered California water quality control laws with fairness, commitment and integrity; and

WHEREAS, Fred Dierker will retire from state service on November 30, 1983;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Water Resources Control Board honors and recognizes the effective service rendered to the people of California and its environment by Fred Dierker; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Water Resources Control Board congratulates Fred Dierker upon his retirement, wishes him well in the future and extends its hope for his happiness.
