RESOLUTION NO. 83-84

CERTIFICATION OF AMENDMENTS TO THE
ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS
ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT (208) PLAN

WHEREAS:

1. In May 1975 the State Board designated the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) as the Areawide Waste Treatment Management (AWTM) Planning Agency for the San Francisco Bay Area pursuant to Section 208 of the Federal Clean Water Act (PL 92-500 as amended). ABAG has developed an AWTM plan and incorporated it into the San Francisco Bay Area Environmental Management Plan (EMP).
2. Federal regulations provide for designated agencies to amend their AWTM plans periodically.
3. ABAG has submitted a Regional Wetlands Plan for Urban Runoff Treatment and a Hazardous Spill Prevention and Response Plan as amendments to the EMP.
4. The Regional Wetlands Plan for Urban Runoff Treatment amendments adds Policy 13 (with related actions), to the Water Quality Chapter of the EMP.
5. The Hazardous Spill Prevention and Response Plan amendments consist of revised wording to Policy 12 of the Water Quality Management Chapter, and revisions to Policy 13 of the Solid Waste Management Chapter of the EMP.
6. The amendments fulfill the requirements and criteria established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for evaluation of AWTM plan amendments.
7. The amendments were adopted in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board certifies the Regional Wetlands Plan for Urban Runoff Treatment, the San Francisco Bay Area Hazardous Spill Prevention and Response Plan, and the associated Policies and Policy Actions as amendments to the San Francisco Bay Area Environmental Management Plan.
2. That the State Board directs the Executive Director to submit the certified amendments to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency for review and approval.
