
WHEREAS, Mildred V. Williamsen provided this service with diligence and perseverance, performing duties throughout various offices of Administrative Services; and


WHEREAS, Mildred V. Williamsen has been active in furthering employee rights having acted in several capacities for the California State Employees Association; and




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Water Resources Control Board extends best wishes for success and happiness to Mildred V. Williamsen in her future activities.
