

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 87- 108

ADOPTION OF THE FINAL "PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION PLAN
FOR THE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLANNING PROGRAM
UNDER SUBSECTION 205(j)(2) AND THE NONPOINT SOURCE PROGRAM
UNDER SUBSECTION 205(j)(5) AND SECTION 319
OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT"

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to Subsections 205(j)(2) and 205(j)(5) and Section 319 of the Federal Clean Water Act and guidance of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) has developed a draft "Program Implementation Plan for the Water Quality Management Planning Program Under Subsection 205(j)(2) and the Nonpoint Source Program Under Subsection 205(j)(5) and Section 319 of the Federal Clean Water Act" (Plan).
2. The State Board has distributed the Plan for review and comment to interested public agencies and parties and has considered the comments received.
3. A Responsiveness Summary was prepared by State Board staff addressing comments and recommendations received on the Plan.
4. The State Board has found that the Plan meets the requirements of the Clean Water Act and EPA guidance and has determined that a Request for Proposals (RPF) should be issued to solicit proposals for projects to be funded, contingent on the availability of funds, pursuant to the Plan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Adopts the final Plan.
2. Directs staff to submit the Plan to EPA for approval.

3. Directs staff to issue a RFP to public agencies in order to solicit proposals for projects to be funded, contingent on the availability of funds, pursuant to the Plan.
