RESOLUTION NO. 88-16

MAKING THE DETERMINATION THAT THE GUALALA COMMUNITY SERVICES SERVICES DISTRICT CLEAN WATER GRANT PROJECT NO. C-06-2978-11 IS ELIGIBLE FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT, SUBJECT TO SUBSEQUENT APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS BY THE BOARD

WHEREAS:


1. The Gualala Community Services District Clean Water Grant project is on the FY 1988 Clean Water Grant Priority List in Priority Class A;
2. The facilities plan for the project will be completed shortly. The proposed cost-effective project is estimated at about \$4.94 million;
3. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that a grantee will be given an eligibility indication at the concept approval stage;
4. The grantee is requesting supplemental state grant assistance in an amount of about \$1.71 million. A final estimate of the amount will be determined at the time of plans and specifications approval and the actual grant amount determined at the time of Approval to Award;
5. The proposed project exceeds the eligibility limit of \$2.5 million and, therefore, the State Board must make a finding that the project is the most cost-effective solution to the water quality and public health problem;
6. The Division of Clean Water Grants has determined that the proposed project, subject to the State Board's approval of the facilities plan, is the most cost-effective solution to the water quality and public health problem;
7. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984, dated May 1985, provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document, provided that the total amount of combined grant assistance shall not exceed 97-1/2 percent of the total project cost; and
8. The State Board may at its option award a supplemental grant equal to an amount less than that amount determined by using the formula referred to in (7) above.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board hereby declares that the Gualala Community Services District project is eligible for a supplemental grant in the approximate amount of \$1.7 million, under the 1984 Clean Water Bond Law, subject to subsequent approval of plans and specifications by the Board.
