WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh served as Executive Officer of the Central Coastal Regional Water Quality Control Board from December 1956 to July 1966.

WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh was Project Director of the San Francisco Bay-Delta Study from July 1966 to September 1973 for investigation and report on wastewater disposal alternatives for the San Francisco Bay Area.

WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh, since September 1973, has served the State Water Resources Control Board in the management of the Board's programs for both water quality and water rights.

WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh served as Assistant Chief and Chief of the Division of Water Quality from January 1974 to January 1981.

WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh served as Chief of the Division of Water Rights from January 1981 to September 1985 and from July 1986 to November 1987.

WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh served as Interim Executive Director of the State Water Resources Control Board from September 1985 to June 1986, providing program guidance for the highest priority programs both for water quality and for water right policies and decisions.

WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh is an able administrator and engineer whose extensive knowledge of California water quality and water resources development and needs has provided expertise for the sound development of water quality and water right programs.


WHEREAS, Raymond Walsh has shown outstanding ability to communicate and willingness to deal with the most difficult issues related to water rights and water quality.

BE it further RESOLVED: That the State Water Resources Control Board wishes Raymond Walsh happiness and fulfillment in his retirement.


