RESOLUTION NO. 88-31

APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE  
TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE, FOR THE COMMUNITY OF TONYVILLE --  
PROJECT NO. C-06-2961-110

WHEREAS:

1. The County of Tulare (Tonyville) project is anticipated to receive an EPA grant in July 1988 for an estimated total eligible cost of \$806,535; and
2. The Tonyville community has a population less than 5,000 and total eligible project costs are estimated to be under \$2.5 million; and
3. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document; and
4. The requested supplemental grant will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5 percent of the project eligible costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Has determined that the County of Tulare (Tonyville) project is eligible to receive a supplemental state grant under the 1984 Clean Water Bond Law.
2. Approves the award of state supplemental grant assistance in the estimated amount of \$288,000 to the County of Tulare on behalf of the community of Tonyville.
