ACCEPTANCE OF THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY,
INVESTIGATIONS BRANCH PHASE II 205(j) REPORT
ENTITLED PROTOCOL DEVELOPMENT: REFERENCE TOXICANT
AND INITIAL COMPLEX EFFLUENT TESTING AS COMPLETION
OF PHASE TWO OF THE ONGOING "MARINE BIOASSAY AND
TOXIC SUBSTANCES CRITERIA DEVELOPMENT" PROJECT

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase II 205(j) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided \$160,000 in Phase II 205(j) funds to the Division of Water Quality, Investigations Branch to conduct, as part of an ongoing project, a study entitled, "Marine Bioassay and Toxic Substances Criteria Development".
2. The Investigations Branch has completed and submitted to the State Board a final report for the second phase of this ongoing project entitled, Marine Bioassay Project, Third Report, Protocol Development: Reference Toxicant and Initial Complex Effluent Testing (Final Report).
3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned final report conforms to the requirements of the EPA Phase II 205(j) Project Workplan entitled "Marine Bioassay and Substances Criteria Development".

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Accepts the aforementioned final report as completion of the Project Workplan.
2. Directs staff to transmit the final report to EPA as completion of the Investigations Branch Project Workplan entitled "Marine Bioassay and Toxic Substances Criteria Development".

3. Directs staff to have the final report published as the third report in its Marine Bioassay Project series.
