AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO  
INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 7-041-250-0 WITH THE  
DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO CONTINUE DEVELOPMENT OF A  
BIOASSAY CERTIFICATION ELEMENT OF THE STATE BOARD'S  
LABORATORY CERTIFICATION PROGRAM THROUGH JUNE 1989

WHEREAS:


1. Section 13176 of the California Water Code mandates that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) develop and operate a laboratory certification program for laboratories analyzing environmental samples, including bioassay analysis techniques.
2. The Department of Fish and Game is developing for the State Board under interagency agreement the necessary protocols for evaluating the capability of laboratories to perform bioassays.
3. The State Board wishes to continue development of such protocols in order to be ready to certify laboratories beginning about June 1989.
4. The Department of Fish and Game has qualified personnel, facilities, and experience to continue development of such protocols and to evaluate the capability of laboratories to conduct bioassay analyses.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute an amendment to Interagency Agreement No. 7-041-250-0 with the Department of Fish and Game for continued development of a bioassay certification element of the State Board's laboratory certification program through June 30, 1989, at a cost not to exceed \$50,000 in FY 1987-88 General Fund monies allocated for the purpose of developing a laboratory certification program.
