RESOLUTION NO. 88-113

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, DAVIS, TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES TO THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD, DIVISION OF LOANS AND GRANTS IN SUPPORT OF THE AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE WATER MANAGEMENT LOAN PROGRAM.

WHEREAS:


1. Many waters of the State of California have been polluted from agricultural drainage water, and many others are threatened with pollution from agricultural drainage water.
2. The people and legislature of the State of California enacted the Water Conservation and Water Quality Bond Law of 1986 to address the serious hazard to the environment from agricultural drainage water.
3. The Water Conservation and Water Quality Bond Law of 1986 requires the State Board to annually submit to the legislature a report on the status of the Agricultural Drainage Water Management Loan Program, including a prioritized list of projects eligible for funding, and the status of agricultural drainage problems on a statewide basis.
4. State Board staff are not equipped to adequately assess agricultural drainage problems on a statewide basis, and the expertise required to perform this assessment exists with the University of California, Davis.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute a contract and amendments thereto with the University of California, Davis, to perform a statewide assessment of agricultural drainage problems, for an amount not to exceed \$137,470 for fiscal years 1987-88 and 1988-89, subject to availability of funds.
