RESOLUTION NO. 89-31

APPROVAL OF STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOANS FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY
OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE EAST BAY MUNICIPAL
UTILITY DISTRICT (EBMUD) PROJECTS

WHEREAS:

1. The federal government has revised the federal Clean Water Act to implement a State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan Program and to phase out the Clean Water Grant Program.
2. The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities".
3. The State Board, on December 15, 1988, adopted the FFY 1989 SRF Loan Program Priority List.
4. The State Board, on February 1, 1989, approved the FFY 1989 SRF Intended Use Plan.
5. The State Board, on February 16, 1989, approved the SWRCB/EPA Operating Agreement.
6. The State Board, on March 16, 1989, authorized submittal of the application for Capitalization Grant to EPA.
7. The Division of Loans and Grants has approved the project report, the environmental document, and the revenue program for both the San Francisco Oceanside Water Pollution Control Plant project and the EBMUD Adeline Street Interceptor project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the San Francisco Oceanside Water Pollution Control Plant and the EBMUD Adeline Street Interceptor projects are approved for SRF loans with repayment periods of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after the first loan payment, or one (1) year after completion of construction, whichever occurs first.
