RESOLUTION NO. 91-5

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR
EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES DISTRICT (EBMUD) FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
A WATER RECLAMATION PROJECT - CHEVRON PROJECT

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" and amended it on September 20, 1990;
2. The State Board, on September 20, 1990, adopted the FFY 1991 SRF Loan Program Priority List and approved the FFY 1991 SRF Intended Use Plan;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the revenue program for the Chevron Reclamation Project; and
4. The information contained in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) prepared for the project has been reviewed and considered (State Clearinghouse No. 88040518), and:
 - A. Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into, the project which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR with respect to the following aspects of the project: (i) biological impacts will be mitigated by using a minimum 100-foot buffer along San Pablo Creek, by using appropriate timing for pipeline placement, by avoiding marsh areas and by replanting with appropriate plant species; and (ii) water quality impacts will be mitigated by monitoring effluent, monitoring ground water extracted during dewatering and providing proper disposal when necessary, minimizing construction across creeks, and using erosion control measures.
 - B. With respect to the other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That a SRF loan of \$17.3 million is approved for the East Bay Municipal Utility District, Chevron Water Reclamation Project No. C-06-4123-110, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment to be due one (1) year after completion of construction.
