AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS TO CONTINUE TO IMPLEMENT THE GROUNDWATER AMBIENT MONITORING AND ASSESSMENT (GAMA) PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Groundwater Quality Monitoring Act of 2001 (AB 599, Liu) required the State Water Resources Control Board to develop a statewide comprehensive groundwater quality monitoring program as part of its GAMA Program;
- 2. Funding is earmarked for GAMA Program implementation; and
- 3. Expenditure authority for contracts that is included in the Fiscal Year 2010-11 budget totals \$1,312,690 from the Waste Discharge Permit Fund (WDPF).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board authorizes the Executive Director or designee to enter into contracts and any amendments thereto, not to exceed \$1,312,690, to continue to implement the Groundwater Ambient Monitoring and Assessment Program.
