The "Stipulation for Order Issuing Stay, With Conditions" entered into by the Cities of Simi Valley and Thousand Oaks, Camarillo Sanitary District, Camrosa Water District, and Ventura County Water Works District No. 1 (collectively referred to as "petitioners") and the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) dated August 14, 2002, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference, is approved. Petitioners' motion for a stay, which is pending before the State Water Resources Control Board, is dismissed without prejudice.

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Petitioners' petition for review of the Regional Board's failure to extend interim chloride limits will be held in abeyance for three years.
