Waiver Fees

- CWC 13269 provides for annual waiver fees
- Fees must be based upon schedule adopted by SWRCB
- 2005 Waiver Resolution requires such fees if schedule adopted by SWRCB
- **2005 Waiver does not include initial enrollment fee or other fees**

Waiver Renewal Options

(Existing Waiver Expires in March 2010)

Waiver Renewal Options Include:

- Renew waiver with minor revisions (with fee schedule?)
- Renew waiver for “minor” projects & General WDRs for larger operations (fees for WDRs)
- Participate in development of a state-wide policy to be adopted by SWRCB
- ***All renewal options include continued Cooperation w/ BOF & USFS to improve Forest Practice Rules & USFS BMPs***
