San Clemente Dam Removal Tour Itinerary

Tour participants must arrive at the starting location no later than 9:15 am, the scheduled start time.

9:15 am – Meet at east parking lot of the Carmel Valley Community Park at 77 W. Carmel Valley Road, Carmel Valley.

If driving from the west on Carmel Valley Road, pass Ford Road and the park, and then turn left to enter the east end of the park and proceed to the gravel area at the back of the parking lot.

- 9:45 am - 10:15 am – Drive to dam with stop at Old Carmel River Dam
- 10:15 am - 10:30 am – Presentation on dam removal project at the dam abutment
- 10:30 am - 11:00 am – Folks walk on dam, talk to project team with follow up questions
- 11:00 am - 11:15 am – Drive out construction route to fish rearing facility
- 11:15 am - 11:45 am – Tour of fish rearing facility
- 11:45 am - 12:15 am – Return to parking lot
