The first phase is to coordinate ongoing CEC efforts within the state. Division of Water Quality, Division of Drinking Water, and OIMA staffs are working with the Regional Water Boards, which are in various phases of existing and pilot monitoring studies. After coordination of monitoring the plan is to take a risk based approach to develop a statewide strategy for addressing CECs in receiving, recycled, and drinking water sources.
