- There are no studies that show harm to humans, either in sickness or deaths, except for Minamoto, Japan in 1955 and 1970 and Baghdad in 1980.




Where is the Harm?

- NIH Standard: for harm of a fetus in a pregnant woman is 65 ppb.
- Recent tests by the NIH on 3,000 people in the U.S. found a maximum of 12 PPB,
- An average of less than 3 PPB.

Where is the Harm?

- Mercury IS USED in medicine and for good health.
- - as germicide in vaccines
- - as fillings in teeth



Where is the Harm?



- Only four species of fish have
- more than **100 ppb** methyl mercury
- **swordfish, shark, king mackerel and tilefish**
