| <b>Project Description</b> | <p>The purpose of this project is to restore an east bound travel lane and embankment at Bear Creek Road by removing and replacing a culvert and repaving the roadway area to achieve original conditions.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Clearing and grubbing the site;</li><li>• Creating access to the culvert on the inlet side;</li><li>• Ramming a new 60" diameter steel culvert over the existing damaged culvert and removing the existing 48 inch CMP culvert;</li><li>• Increasing the size of the upstream headwall to accommodate the larger pipe;</li><li>• Constructing a soil nail wall with a concrete face to facilitate rebuilding of the existing roadway; and,</li><li>• Constructing a grouted rip rap slope protection and energy dissipater spillway.</li></ul> <p>Mitigation: 590 sq. ft of riparian land will be restored.</p> |
