Project Description	<p>The purpose of this project is to improve vehicular circulation and pedestrian access to the County park and beach.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removing any existing asphalt concrete pavement and the existing culvert pipe; • Removing vegetation from the creek and scarifying the creek and swale areas; • Installing a minimum 12-foot wide paved roadway, providing a minimum 2.5 inches of asphalt concrete over 10 inches aggregate base; • Installing a concrete single headwall at the culvert inlet; and • Installing a graded swale. <p>No compensatory mitigation is proposed for this project.</p> <p>County of Santa Barbara filed a (Mitigated) Negative Declaration in September 2016.</p>
