Project Description	<p>The purpose of this project is to develop a well-designed residential community consistent with the Glen Loma Ranch Specific Plan.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Developing approximately 213 acres of the westerly portion of Glen Loma Ranch for a mix of residential, commercial, and other uses; • Filling approximately 113 linear feet in the headcut area of one small drainage; • Constructing a clear span bridge over Reservoir Canyon Creek; • Realigning, lengthening, and restoring the riparian corridor the channelized reach of McCutchin Creek. <p>Compensatory mitigation for this project includes: preserving 0.41 acres of wetland, 0.27 acres of streambed, and 11.48 acres of riparian habitat; and, creating 1.33 acres of wetland, 1.33 acres of streambed, and 3.2 acres of riparian habitat.</p> <p>The City of Gilroy filed an Environmental Impact Report on November 5, 2005 and May 19, 2014.</p>
