Project Description	<p>The purpose of this project is to stabilize and enhance the unprotected and eroding southwestern bank of Pismo Creek.</p> <p>The project activities include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demolishing the existing fencing and removing debris along the creek bank; • Installing inlet protection, fiber rolls, and silt fences to reduce erosion potential; • Clearing and grubbing vegetation that will not remain after construction; • Removing 19 willow trees; • Installing a cofferdam along a 100-foot bank segment, and dewatering the construction area; • Trenching behind the toe of the slope in the dewatering area; • Placing heavy ½ or ¼ ton class stone in the trench; • Excavating approximately 900 linear feet of bank; • Installing geogrid fabric, layered in alternating patterns for structural integrity; • Re-planting the geogrid with live-cut willow and cottonwood branches from the project site; and • Hydro-seeding the geogrid fabric and any disturbed areas upon completion of the work. <p>No mitigation is proposed for this project. The California Coastal Commission filed an (Mitigated) Negative Declaration.</p>
